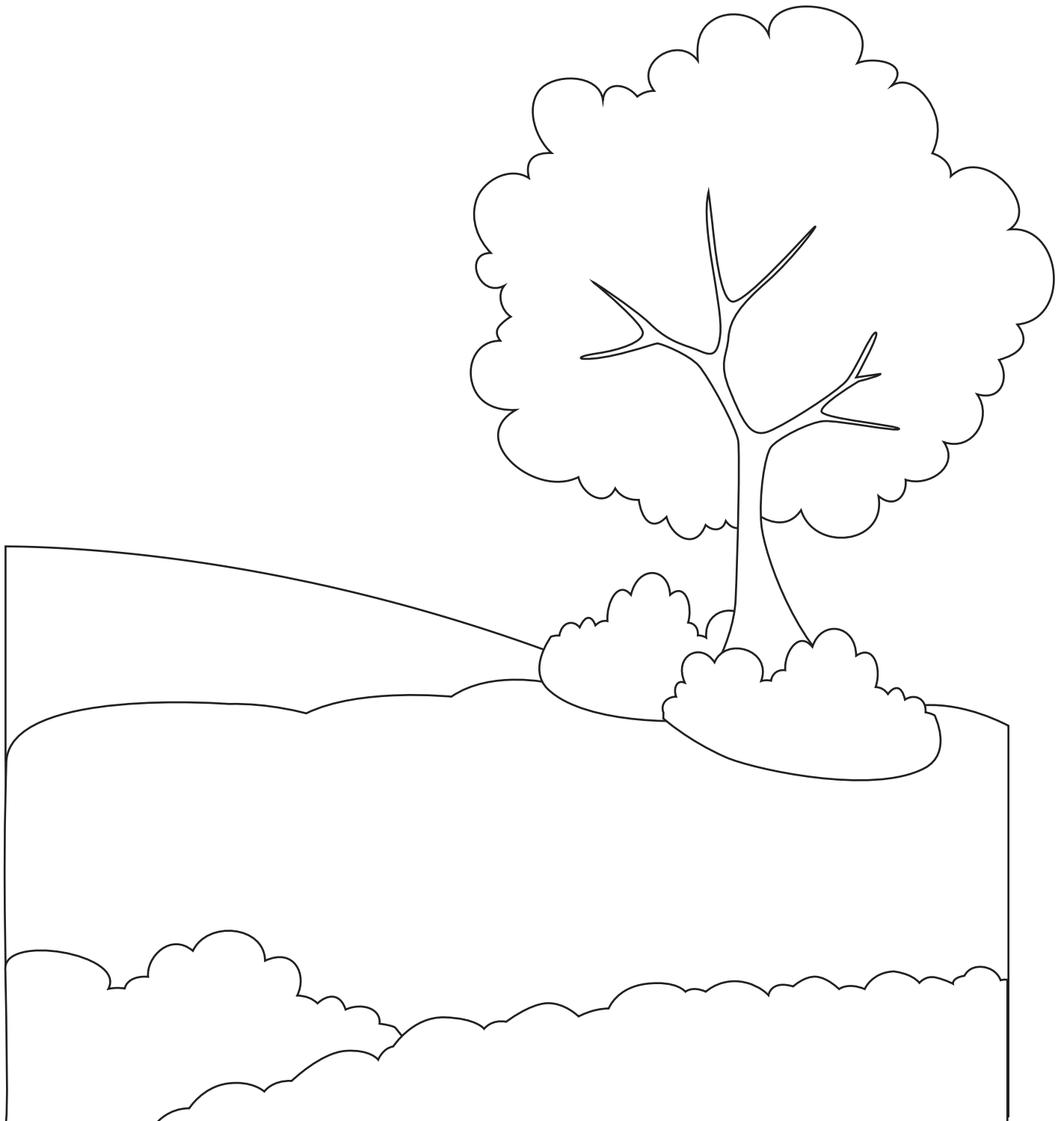



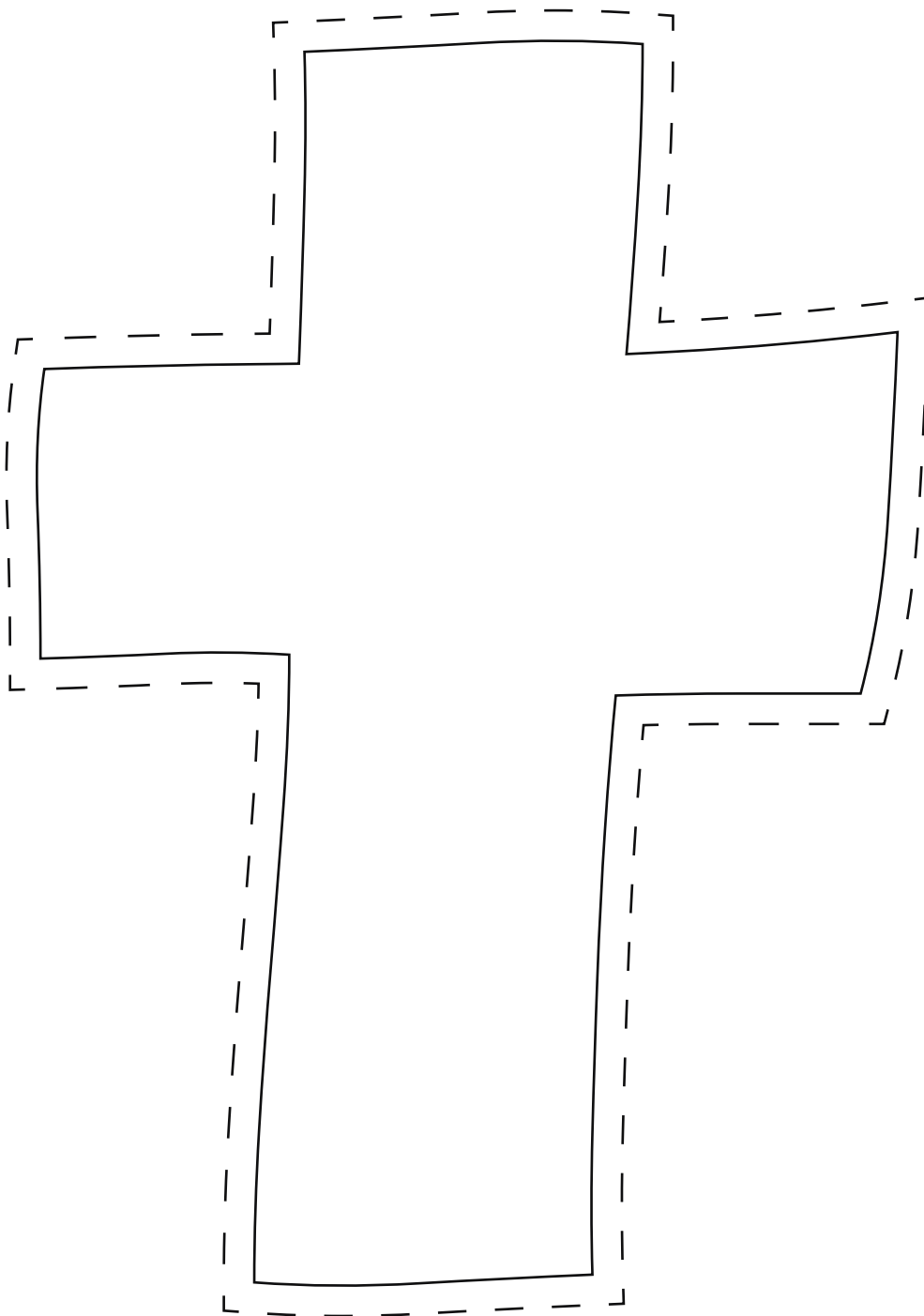

**Activity: Color, Cut + Demonstrate**

**DEVOTIONAL** Do you know what a tomb is?
