### Casserole Ministry Outreach



On the Second Friday of each month we partner with Bmore caring to feed people experiencing homelessness in our area. Volunteers donate casseroles which are divided and packaged as individual servings. If you would like to volunteer, contact Cindy Butz or the parish office.

### **NCEON (North County Emergency Outreach Network)**

NCEON continues to provide both food and financial aid to many in our North County community. Items that are currently needed include:

Peanut butter and jelly (all size jars), canned soup, packages and boxes of mashed potatoes (all sizes), boxes of shelf stable milk, ground coffee, tea bags, and sugars

Donations can be brought to any worship celebration. Financial donations are also needed. If giving a check, make it payable to LHUMC and put NCEON in line item



Ferndale UMC distributes food from their pantry at their bimonthly Social Saturday, which are the 2nd and 4th Saturdays, from 9am to 11am. Last month we served 84 adults and 64 children for a total of 148 people.

### **UMCOR Hygiene Kits**

UMCOR has issued a challenge to raise 10,000 hygiene kits. LHUMC and the NCCP are answering that challenge with plans to pack 1000 kits. There is a great need for these basic items due to the many recent natural disasters including floods, hurricanes and wild fires. These kits can be economically packed when the items are purchased in bulk. Items can be purchased from the Amazon wish list (see the QR code) or through donations to LHUMC with a notation for "HYGIENE KITS". Each kit will cost \$5.75 which includes the cost of items and the shipping from the distribution center to the disaster location. (If items are purchased individually the cost is \$14.00). A little goes a long way when we work together. How many kits will you sponsor? The kits will be assembled in a Parrish packing party at LHUMC much like when we packed cleaning buckets. During that packing party we packed 203 5-gallon buckets in 15 minutes. Many hands make light work. Plan to be there. You don't want to miss this! Watch for this date.




### **GET CONNECTED**




